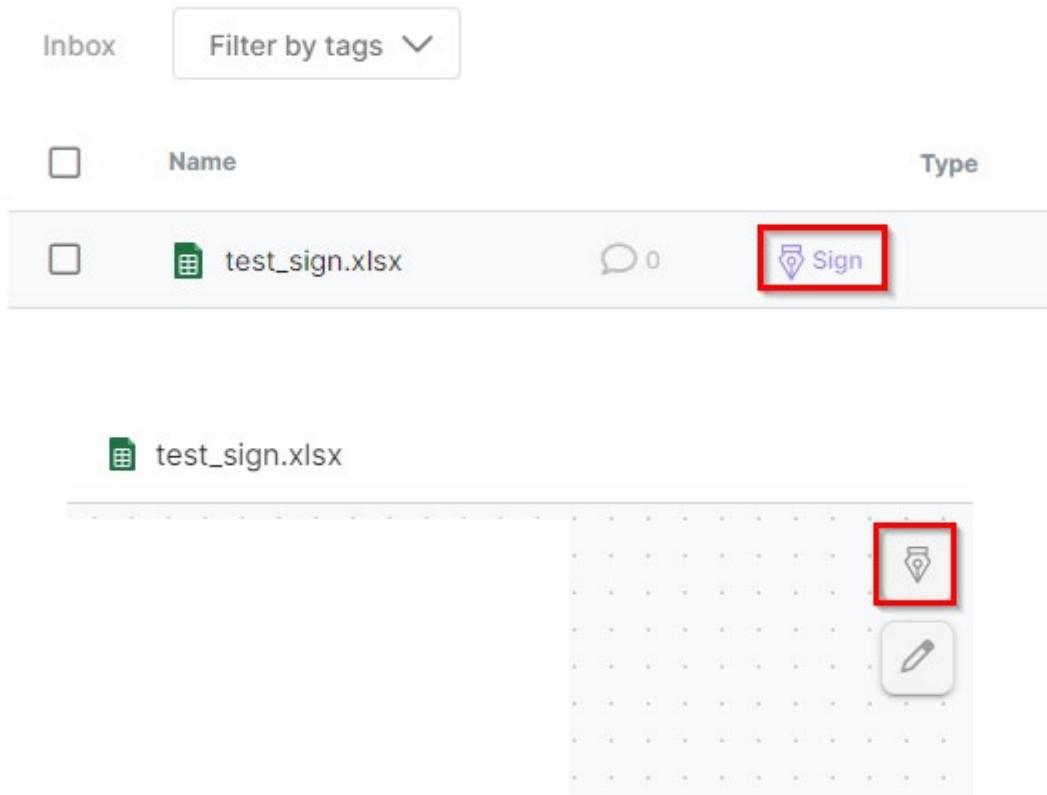


Signing Excel documents from the DeepBox

It is now possible to sign Excel files (.xlsx) from the DeepBox. The "Sign" button automatically creates a copy of the Excel document in PDF format, which is saved in the same storage location and used for the signature process.

Improved DeepID verification process for organisations

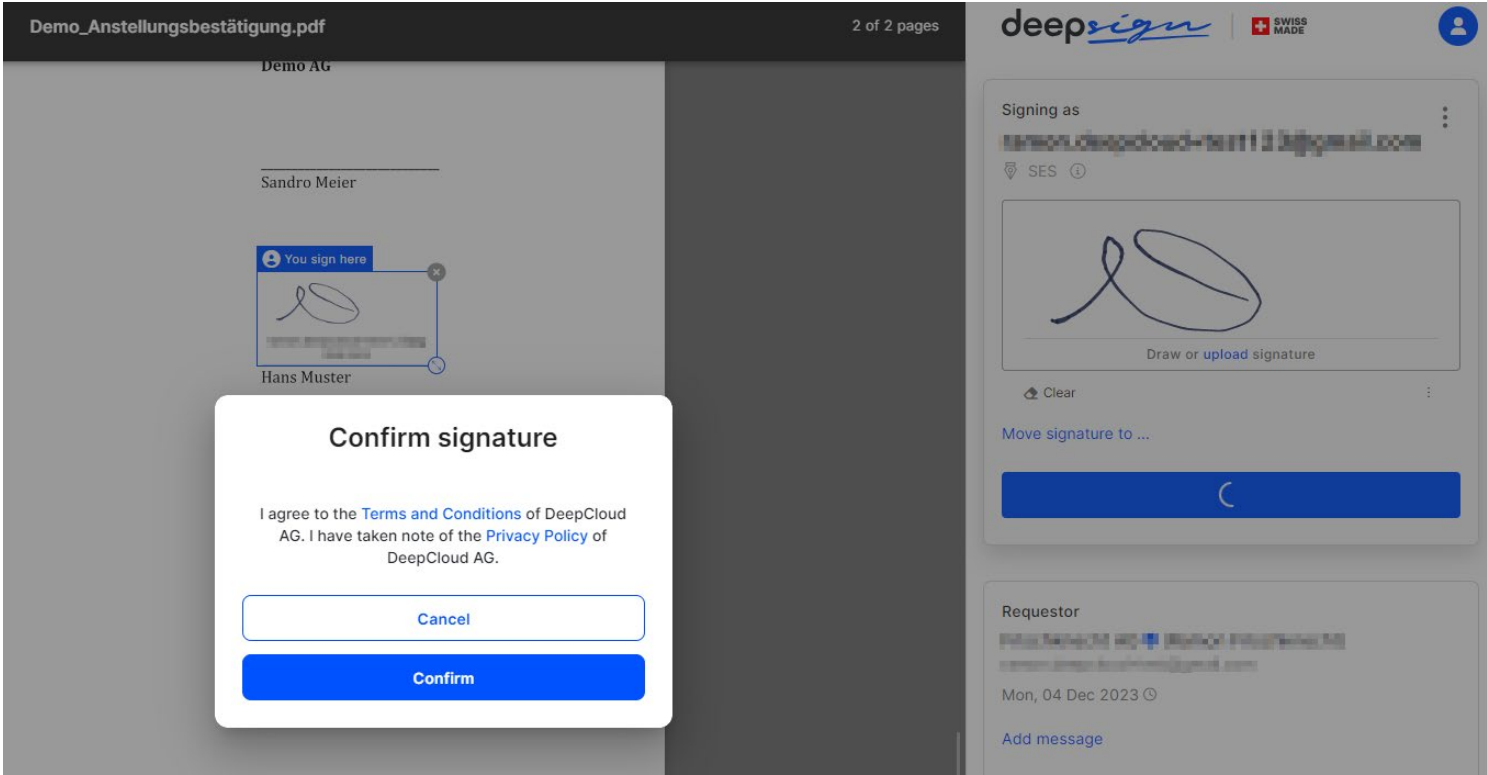
During the verification process of an organisation, the name comparison with the commercial register was optimised.

Security optimisation: Lock account after failed login attempts

After five failed login attempts, the DeepCloud account will be temporarily locked. Once the account has been locked, a corresponding notification will be sent by e-mail, which can be used to reactivate the account.

GTC dialogue optimised for signatures without a DeepCloud account

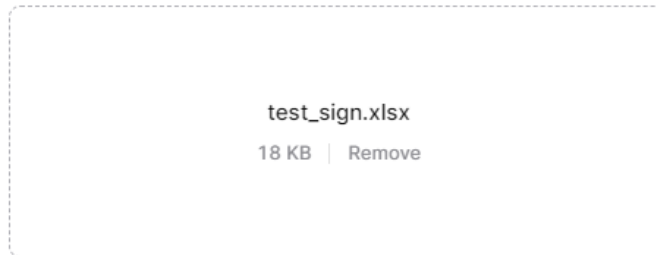
When signing simple electronic signatures without a DeepCloud account, it is no longer necessary to accept the full DeepCloud terms and conditions. It is sufficient to accept the shortened terms of use.



Upload Excel files to DeepSign

Excel files (.xlsx) can now also be uploaded to the DeepSign Cockpit. The file is automatically converted into a PDF, whereby the last workbook used is selected for the conversion.
